Information We Collect

We may collect the following information:

- Name
- Email address
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Legislative district information
- Advocacy interests and campaign participation
- Information voluntarily provided through forms, surveys, petitions, or event registrations

How We Use Your Information

We use your information to:

- Send advocacy alerts and action opportunities
- Communicate legislative updates and organizational news
- Process event registrations and participation
- Improve our programs and services
- Respond to inquiries and requests
- Comply with legal and regulatory obligations

SMS Consent

If you choose to opt in to receive text messages from The Arc of California, your mobile phone number will be used solely for the purpose of delivering SMS communications related to advocacy, events, organizational updates, and account notifications. SMS consent is not required to participate in our programs or services.

Mobile Information Sharing

No mobile information will be shared with third parties or affiliates for marketing or promotional purposes. Text messaging originator opt-in data and consent will not be shared with any third parties except service providers that support the delivery of text messages on behalf of The Arc of California.

Information Sharing

The Arc of California and The Arc of the United States does not sell, rent, or trade personal information. We may share information with trusted service providers who assist us in operating our website, advocacy platform, email communications, and text messaging services. These providers are required to protect your information and use it only for authorized purposes.

We may also disclose information when required by law.

We take reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, or misuse. However, no method of internet transmission or electronic storage can be guaranteed to be completely secure.
